An examination of one of Strauss' most popular operas, full of romance, comedy, fabulous music, and nostalgia for the days of Old Vienna. Special emphasis will be given to the influence of librettist Hugo von Hofmannsthal on Strauss' writing for the voice. The four-week course will culminate with attendance at the Metropolitan Opera Live in HD broadcast of "Der Rosenkavalier" at the Douglass Theater on Saturday, April 15, 2023. Admission to the broadcast performance is \$20 for seniors.

- Placing new folders in a records carton.

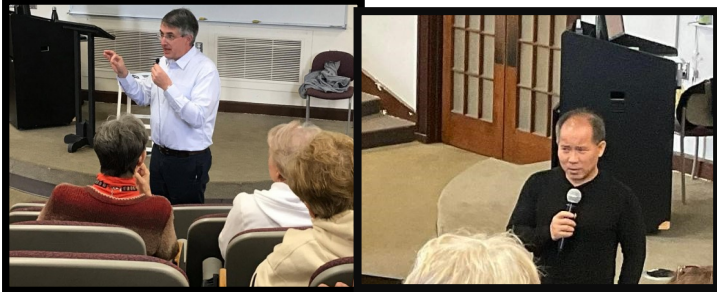
