Wesleyan College Arboretum.**

Where to meet and park: Parking lot next to the Mathews Athletic Center and tennis courts at Wesleyan College

GPS Coordinates: 32.873303, -83.719890

Notes: Trails in the Arboretum are relatively level with a dirt surface. Restrooms and water are available at the nearby Mathews Athletic Center; in addition, there is a drinking fountain at the Anderson Cabin in the Arboretum.

Expected Highlights: birds and other wildlife; the Arboretum trails and forest

**2) March 28, 3:00 – 4 PM:
Amerson River Park**

Where to meet and park: Parking lot at the children’s playground and picnic pavilion

GPS Coordinates: 32.874612, -83.653473

Notes: The trail is level and is paved; note that the path may be shared by cyclists, joggers, and dog walkers. Restrooms and water are available at the playground.

Expected Highlights: birds and floodplain forests; views of the Ocmulgee River
