The Wesleyan College Open World Scholarship (OWS) Nomination Form

The Open World scholarship is a need-based scholarship and is awarded to an incoming international student who is passionate about professional, academic, and personal development for themselves and others. As Wesleyan College's most prestigious international award, this scholarship provides international women students, outside of the United States a full scholarship (including tuition, fees, and room and board) while they receive the education that will empower them to lead in their chosen field.

Students must be nominated for the OWS by educators or Wesleyan College educational partners. Educators must complete the nomination form, notify the student being nominated, and submit the completed form to Yasmin Pineda at ypineda@wesleyancollege.edu. The student will then be invited to complete the application. The responsibility to review the financial documents of the student's family lies solely with the school counselor. The deadline to nominate and submit all documents for OWS is **February 1st, 2024**.

Requirements:

- Predicted scores 90 percent or above (CBSE/ISC/State Board) OR 40 points (IBDP) OR AA and A* (Cambridge Curriculum)
- Has received the International entrance scholarship of \$13,000 to \$15,000 on their acceptance letter.
- The **annual** family income must be \$6,000 (INR 5,00,000) or less.
- Two Letter of Recommendation (Principal, Teacher or Counselor)
- Resume/Profile (include Co-Curricular and highest accolades)
- Three essay questions (2 written, 1 video)

The Finalists will be invited for a virtual interview
